School Cash Online

School Cash Online is a computer application authorized by the school Board to track permission forms and allow for online payments. If you are not already registered, we request that you do so right away. Parents/guardians will use a secure online account to complete forms and process payments. Payment can be made through credit card, by EFT directly from your bank account, or by using a visa/mastercard debit style card.

Parents/guardians can select to receive email notification when a new item becomes available. Items are personalized to each student. For example, if Grade 2 students are attending a field trip, the option to pay for the field trip will only be visible to parents of those students. To create an account go to
